CHARITY OF CHOICE: LITTERS N' CRITTERS RESCUE

Jane Jorgensen retired from nursing in November 2012 and since then, she dived head first into a passion of hers, helping dogs in rescue. She began to volunteer for Litters 'n Critters Rescue, and since then has fostered more than 200 dogs and puppies at her farm in Wallace Bay, just outside Pugwash, NS. Jane and her husband, Gordon, previously ran a dairy farm in Wallace Bay, and since they retired from dairy farming, they were able to transform the dairy barn into dog boarding kennels and the milk room into a grooming salon. Jane now runs the boarding kennel, where she can keep the rescue dogs safely, and runs a grooming salon, where she can take any dog, rescue or not, no matter how matted and tangled their fur is, and make them look like a million dollars. Some dogs come into rescue unable to move because their fur is matted so tightly. When Litters n Critters did 2 mass rescues from Northern Labrador, Jane took all the pregnant Mom's and the Moms with puppies, and wound up with 16 pups and 4 Mother dogs in her kennels. Jane looked after every pup and Mom and they all eventually went to their forever homes. Since the passing of her husband, Gordon, in September of last year, Jane has continued to take foster dogs in even though it's a lot of work, but it is her passion. Jane also looks after her family farm, which has several of her own dogs and cats, as well horses, chickens, a donkey, sheep, llamas, and alpacas. Jane contributes so much to Litters n Critters Rescue, it's hard to put it into words, but we all know this world is a much better place for dogs, with her in it.
